Number and Amount of Award

One (1) \$1,000.00 non-renewable scholarship. Payments will be sent directly to the recipient's college in two (2) installments: \$500.00 first semester and \$500.00 second semester. One (1) runner-up will be chosen in the event of the recipient's ineligibility.

Eligibility

This scholarship will be awarded to a non-traditional student interested in a medical career who meets the following:

- *Must be a non-traditional student (i.e., going back to college to make a career change into the medical field) and have a financial need.

- *Must attend an accredited post-secondary institution such as college, vocational or community college in the state of Nebraska.

- *Must have received a minimum score of 20 on the ACT, 850 on the SAT or the following minimum scores on the COMPASS test: 62 in Writing, 76 in Reading and 50 in Pre-Algebra.

- *Must be a resident of Hall County.

Criteria

- *Qualified ACT, SAT or COMPASS examination score.

- *Transcript of grades.

- *Typed essay (minimum of 350 words) describing why the candidate should receive this scholarship and how it will benefit their medical career.

- *Personal interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee.

- *Two (2) letters of recommendation from: (no form letters accepted)
 - Employer
 - Community Member

- *Completed application form, ACT, SAT or COMPASS test results, personal essay and letters of recommendation are to be submitted as one portfolio to:
