PARKING



Having a baby - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, expectant parents use the main entrance of the hospital and Parking Lot A.

Inpatient Admissions - When you arrive at Saint Francis for a hospital stay, you'll find registration just inside the main entrance next to Parking Lot A.

Visiting - Use Parking Lot A. Inside the main entrance, you'll find information to make your visit more enjoyable.

Cardiac Rehab - For cardiopulmonary rehabilitation, use Parking Lot B, adjacent to the Cardiopulmonary Rehab entrance.

Outpatient Procedures - If you're coming to Saint Francis for procedures such as X-rays, lab, or cardiac testing, use the outpatient entrance on the northeast side of the hospital. Convenient parking is available in Parking Garage F.

Outpatient Surgery and MRI - For short-stay surgery or an MRI, admissions and procedures will be available using the entrance adjacent to Parking Lot D.

Emergency - If you are seeking emergency care, the emergency department is located on the northeast side of Saint Francis utilizing Parking Lot G.
